### The Word of God

Once in a while God manages to break through to our consciousness. Now and then God makes Himself strikingly real to us--reveals himself in powerful and dramatic ways. That's what happened when Jesus took Peter, James, and John up onto a high mountain. There the three disciples saw Jesus transfigured.

God comes to us in the terrible moments of our lives--and in the wonderful moments, too. God comes to us in quiet moments--in unexpected ways--to reveal Christ to us--to draw us to Christ--to change our lives. The challenge of today's Gospel is for us to avoid haste and anxiety to take time of guiet reflection so that we can grow in awareness of the power of God in our lives.

#### **Kilkerley Finance Committee** (The Parochial House)

The Parochial House has been empty since Fr. Gerry moved to Knockbridge in April and we want to progress with the necessary renovation required to leave the house habitable and future proof for at least the next ten years and also to allow Fr. Rushe to take up residence in it as soon as possible.

The committee would prefer not to have to borrow more funds from the Diocese or to have to engage in further fundraising (as in the refurbishment of the church) and more on burden parishioners. An alternative would be to sell the house at the graveyard, which is in a declining state of repair and use the proceeds to fund the Parochial House renovations. To this end we are putting this house on the open market for sale to ascertain what price would be achievable. Therefore, a 'for sale' sign will be placed on the house early next week & depending on interest we will decide on what is the best financial option for the parish to fund the necessary renovations.
